## Pre-Loved Uniform Sale

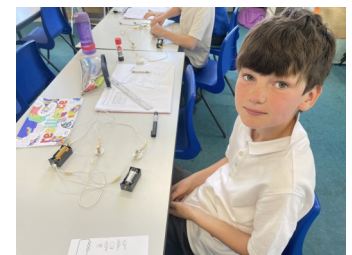
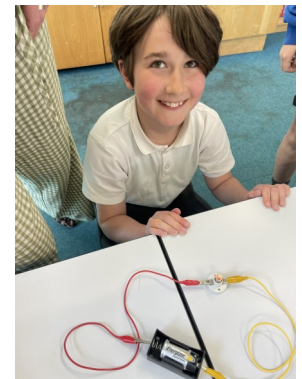
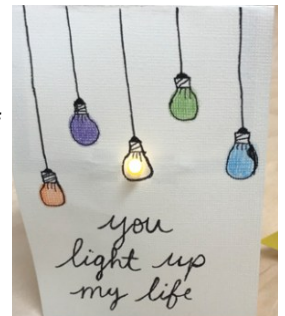

## Safeguarding / Health & Safety

### Online Safety - Key Messages for Your Child

- **Keep it private:** Never share your full name, location, school, or passwords. Use nicknames and avatars instead of real photos when gaming or joining new communities.
- **Strangers are strangers:** Remember that people online might not be who they claim to be.
- **Think before you click:** Do not open strange links, attachments, or pop-ups from unknown sources, as they can contain viruses or nasty messages.
- **Double-check AI and facts:** When using new AI tools, remember that they can make mistakes. Always double-check information on trusted websites and do not let AI replace your own creativity.
- **Speak up:** If anyone or anything online makes you feel upset, confused, or worried turn off the screen, block the user, and tell a trusted adult.
